- Led a migration of a greenfield project from Astro to Nuxt 4 / Vue 3 to improve maintainability and delivery speed.
- Collaborated with Product and Design to scope work, break down requirements, and deliver user-facing features iteratively.
- Mentored a mid-level engineer across technical delivery, communication, organisation, and stakeholder management.
- Introduced Agile rituals and improved cross-team communication to reduce ambiguity and increase delivery cadence.

- Led development of a shared design system and component library in React, adopted across teams to improve consistency and reduce build time.

- Built reusable Embeddable Web Components to support cross-app journeys and A/B testing with React, enabling consistent experiences across platforms.
- Developed internal tooling to streamline frontend deployments to AWS using SST (CDK wrapper) and CloudFormation.
- Implemented and refined CI/CD pipelines with DevOps, automating unit and E2E test execution to improve release confidence.
- Reduced main site load times from roughly 10s to under 2s through refactoring, simplification, and performance optimisation while maintaining SEO.
